Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I sign up?

A: We will be holding a sign-up night on January 22nd and 23rd at 6:30—7:30 at the Harbor Golf Community Center. If you can't make it that night, please feel free to reach out to Jocelyn at recreationelbow@gmail.com or 306-860-8023 to make arrangements to pay your fees.

Q: How does the fee structure work?

A: For a flat fee, you can have access to ALL Elbow Sanctioned Events from January 22nd—March 31st. This includes sports events and family open gym time. Fitness Centre memberships are separate.

Q: I have a friend/family member here visiting—can they come for one night (or only a few days)?

A: Sure! The more the merrier! The drop-in fee is \$10 for adults, \$5 for students, or \$20 for families.

Q: If I want to sign up halfway through the season, what will this cost?

A: You're welcome to pick between paying the full rate or paying the drop-in rate if you'd like.

Q: I'd like to buy a membership for longer than 10 weeks—how do I do that?

A: We are running this session as a pilot to see how it works. By only charging for 10 weeks, we have an opportunity to make changes as necessary for our next sessions. Watch for details about longer programs coming soon!

Q: Can I have access to the auditorium at any time with this pass?

A: At this time, this pass can only be used for the events in the calendar labelled "ESE" (short for Elbow Sanctioned Events).

Q: How will you keep track of who shows up?

A: Please sign in on the sheet provided so we can evaluate the success of our Elbow Sanctioned Events Pilot Program.

Q: What happens if a private booking bumps a time slot?

A: Private bookings subsidize the low fees we're able to offer for this program, so Private Bookings will take priority but we'll ensure to reschedule and don't foresee this to be much of a problem at this time.

Q: What age groups is this open to?

A: The sport-specific events are open to high school aged students and adults. The Family Open Gym is open to all ages, as long as adults are supervising their children. Please note that supervision is not the responsibility of the Village of Elbow and will not be provided.
