


**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ELBOW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS**


As per Section 38(3) of *The Municipalities Act*, the Council of the Village of Elbow, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaws may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Every person who contravenes any provision of any Bylaw of the Village of Elbow is guilty of an offense and liable upon summary conviction:
  - a. To the penalty specified in the bylaw or in another bylaw providing for a penalty with respect to the contravention of that bylaw; or
  - b. If no penalty is provided for by the bylaw:
    - i. First offence: \$500
    - ii. Second and any offence thereafter: \$1000
3. Bylaw 81-01 is hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final reading thereof.
