A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ELBOW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

As per Section 38(3) of *The Municipalities Act,* the Council of the Village of Elbow, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaws may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 2. Every person who contravenes any provision of any Bylaw of the Village of Elbow is guilty of an offense and liable upon summary conviction:
 - To the penalty specified in the bylaw or in another bylaw providing for a penalty with respect to the contravention of that bylaw; or
 - b. If no penalty is provided for by the bylaw:

i. First offence: \$500

- ii. Second and any offence thereafter: \$1000
- 3. Bylaw 81-01 is hereby repealed.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final reading thereof.
