BYLAW No. 80.

A Bylaw of the Village of Elbow to licence and regulate the use of Drays.

The Council of the Village of Elbow enacts as follows,

1. Every person who owns a dray or other vehicle used for draying hauling or delivering for hire in the Village shall obtain a licence from the Secretary Treasurer of the Village and shall pay in advance a licence fee of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars.
2. No person shall follow or carry on the business, trade or calling of draying for hire without first having obtained such licence and paid the licence fee.
3. Every person to whom a licence is granted under this bylaw shall have his dray at the call of the public at least eight hours in each working day and shall, when hired to unload a car, unload such car within forty-eight hours after such hiring if requested to do so by the hirer, and, if such licensee neglects or refuses to do so, the hirer may employ any person not having a licence to unload such car in which case such person shall not be guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
4. All licences granted under this bylaw shall expire on the thirty-first day of December next succeeding the date of the same.
5. The person in whose name a licence is taken out shall be deemed the owner of the dray or vehicle licenced and shall be liable to the penalties imposed for an infraction of this bylaw whether committed by him or by an employee.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
7. Bylaw No. 18 approved June 4th., 1910 is hereby repealed.

A Public Meeting of Ratepayers of Village of Elbow was held on August 19th. with the Overseer in the chair and 30 in attendance.

The Secretary read the Petition and notice calling the meeting. On the motion of Tamar Jackson seconded by Roland Dykes the Council was requested not to dispose of the rink lumber until an attempt has been made to form an organization to re-erect the rink.

Tamar Jackson spokesman for the Curling Club, Recreation Association and Sports Association stated it was the opinion of these bodies that a Co-operative Rink Association should be formed.
