HUNDEBY: That we write Marathon Realty and tell them that we have tried to remove the concrete from the water tank site. We would appreciate it if they could send some specifications on the concrete pilings, and recommendations as to how other villages or towns have removed theirs. CD.

WANKEL: That David Epp be hired until December 31, 1983. CD.

GALLANT: That we send a financial report to the Cemetery Association for the year 1982.

ECTOR: That we write a letter to Walter Berndt requesting a 20% down payment of \$400.00. CD.

GALLANT: That we write Mike Griffin thanking him for his letter about the Civic Centre heating system but the council feels that the situation has been remedied. CD.

HUNDEBY: RESOLUTION R4-82

WANKEL: That Darlene Martens can come in to help Valerie with year end.

GALLANT: That the topic of sending water bills every other month be tabled until the January 3rd meeting. CD.

GALLANT: Jean Dell'Oro can purchase lot 4 Block 2. CD.

GALLANT: That we write Gordon Book and thank him for his letter RE the hardware auctions in the Village, but any further discussion will be tabled until the February meeting. CD.

Kurt Greggerson (Fire Cheif) attended the council meeting to advise the council as to what equipment is needed by the department.

HUNDEBY: That we purchase a 2½" nozzle, 300' of 2½" hose, a 2½" gate valve, and an adapter, as recommended by Kurt Greggerson.

WANKEL: That Gordon Books propse irrigation project on the effected Village property be approved, but we will write the Sask. Environment about two things: 1)we weren't aware that Mr. H.A. Aaro owns any of the land in question. 2) Mr. Book has not approached the council about his project intentions.
