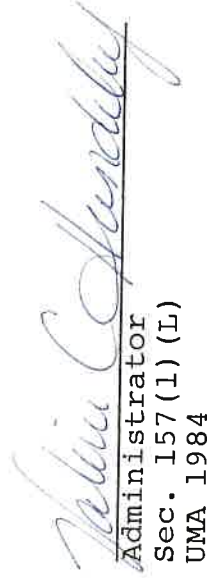
BYLAW 89/9

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE A UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR THE  
NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS IN  
THE VILLAGE OF ELBOW

The Council of the Village of Elbow in the Province  
of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That a uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings as shown on the attached map and which shall become part of this bylaw shall be used in the Village of Elbow.
2. That all existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming with the provisions of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
3. A separate number shall be assigned for each existing lot being legally surveyed and registered.
4. Each house and/or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear a separate number.
5. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
6. The Administrator of the Village of Elbow shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
7. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

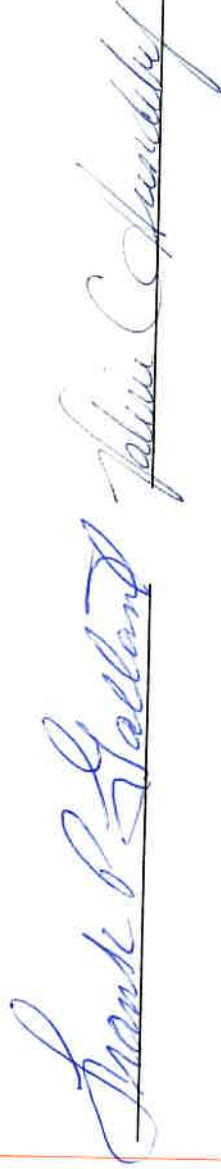

BYLAW 89-11

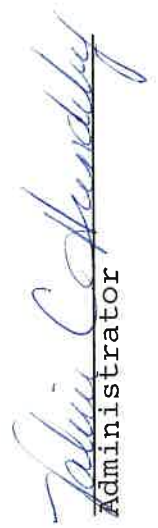
A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ELBOW  
TO REGULATE PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE AND THE DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE  
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ELBOW

The Council of the Village of Elbow in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The regulations governing plumbing and drainage made by the Minister of Health and approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the Public Health Act shall apply to and govern all plumbing and drainage in the Village of Elbow except as hereinafter altered or revised.
2. Application for a plumbing permit shall be made by the plumbing contractor on a prescribed form, and accompanied by the required fee, to the Village Administrator.
3. The fee for a permit issued by the health region in respect of an application shall be:
  - a) \$25.00 for installation from 3 to 10 fixtures and \$5.00 for each additional fixture.
  - b) \$20.00 for any installation or alteration where not more than two fixtures or devices are to be erected or installed.
  - c) \$20.00 for the installation of a private sewage works.
  - d) \$20.00 for a permanent connection of an existing plumbing system to a sewage works and/or water works.
4. The plumbing inspector, upon the approval and recommendation of the medical health officer, shall be a public health inspector of the health region.
5. All persons undertaking the installation or repairing of or the addition to a plumbing system shall be in possession of a certificate of qualification as a journeyman plumber or a second class plumber's status certificate issued by the Department of Labor.
6. a) Any person who infringes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a period not exceeding fourteen days.  
b) The imposition of a fine for failure to comply with the provisions of this bylaw shall not relieve the person in default from complying therewith and he shall be liable on summary conviction to a further fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00 for each day after the first fine is imposed until he has complied with the provisions of the bylaw.

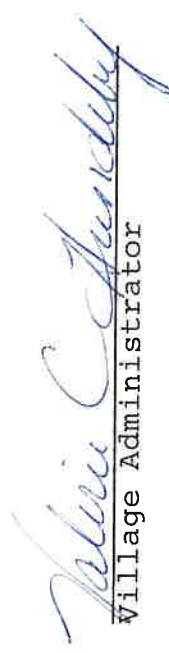

BYLAW NO. 89-1

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR SHORT-TERM BORROWING

The Council of the Village of Elbow, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Mayor and Treasurer of the Municipality are hereby authorized to borrow from the Elbow Credit Union the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) required to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality until the taxes and grants receivable for the current year are available and to pay or agree to pay interest thereon either in advance or at maturity, and in either case after maturity, at the rate of the current borrowing interest rate per annum.
2. The amount to be borrowed to meet the current expenditures does not exceed the actual or estimated total revenues from the municipal taxes levied and unconditional provincial or federal grants receivable in the current year (excluding school taxes or taxes levied for other than general municipal purposes).

4. The amount so borrowed shall be a first charge upon the taxes levied for general municipal purposes and upon the unconditional provincial or federal grants receivable in the current year.

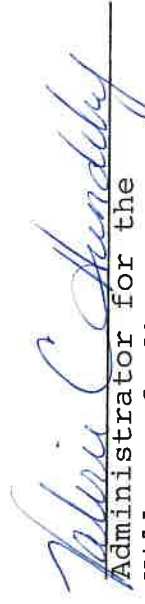
