

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF FIRE BANS


The Council of the Village of Elbow in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Council may at their discretion issue, amend or cancel a fire ban for the Village of Elbow.
2. Any ban issued pursuant to this bylaw includes all outdoor fires, fireworks and charcoal use but does not include propane barbeques and firepits.
3. Any person found to be in contravention of any part of this bylaw is subject to a fine of \$1000.
4. Any person occupying a spot in any of the campgrounds within the Village of Elbow (Elbow Sunset Suites, Tufts Bay campground) found to be in contravention of this bylaw is subject to a fine of \$1000 and may be evicted from the campground and be prohibited from returning for up to three (3) years.
5. The Staff of the Village of Elbow, upon the issuance of a fire ban pursuant to this bylaw, will as soon as practicable communicate the issuing of the fire ban in a manner they deem appropriate.
