

Mail-in Ballot Request Procedures:

As per the Village of Elbow Mail-In Ballot Voting System Bylaw #7-2024:
Sections 3-6 as below:

3. A voter who desires to vote by mail shall apply for a mail-in ballot kit, by filling out:

- (a) a Voter's Registration Form – Form R, Schedule A.
- (b) the Declaration of Person Requesting a Mail-in Ballot – Form C, Schedule B

4. Schedule A & B may be witnessed by either:

- (a) the returning officer;
- (b) the deputy returning officer;
- (c) the enumerator;
- (d) a Commissioner of Oaths; or
- (e) a Notary Public

5. A voter who desires to vote by mail shall apply in person or by submitting via mail no later than 30 days before election day. **(no later than October 11, 2024)**

6. Upon receiving the voter's application (Schedule A & Schedule B), for a mail-in ballot, the returning officer shall note the date of approval in the appropriate area of Schedule A.

These forms are available to be picked up in the office during regular office hours, sent to you by e-mail or mailed by regular mail.
