CPR/FIRST AID

The Village of Elbow is offering a full blended learning course in January for Standard First Aid, CPR C, and AED. This course provides comprehensive Red Cross certification. If you've completed your training more than 3 years ago or have yet to take the course before, then this is for you! The course includes the latest First Aid and CPR guidelines and meets federal and provincial Standard First Aid and CPR requirements. The blended learning course is delivered in two parts: a self-paced online component (focusing on theory) and an 8-hour in-class component focusing on skill development. (Sunday, January 19, 2025 - 8:30 am - 4:00 pm at Harbor Golf Community Center) The online component must be completed before attending the classroom session.

POWER OUTAGES IN ELBOW

As you know by now, we have a generator! Thank you to SaskWater & Cory Ganes for all the assistance in getting this project completed. Luckily, we have not experienced any power outages since installation.

WATER METER DISCONNECTIONS

We have begun a water meter replacement plan. If you are on this year's list, we will contact you to have your meter replaced. We plan to replace approximately 30 meters this year so that all of our meters read in cubic meters and replace any that are quite old. At the end of this program, we will have all meters changed/upgraded so that all meter reads will automatically be sent directly to the office. No more in person meter reads!

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

There is no longer the option for residents to turn these back in for storage while away. If you are away for an extended period of time, please store in a safe place on your property. We will send out the 2025 Loraas schedule once we have it.

The TRANSFER STATION is now closed for the season.
