#### COUNCIL NOTES

Welcome to our *new Mayor, Glen Gardner*. His term officially began on May 13, 2024. Glen is a wonderful addition to the team and we welcome his breadth of knowledge!

Council passed the 2024 Capital and Operating Budgets at the April Council Meeting. A copy is posted on the Village Website. The mill rate and base tax remain unchanged from 2023.

Council designated Elevator Road as the truck route to preserve the surface of Railway Avenue/South Elbow Drive. Signs are to be posted and businesses informed.

The repairs to the intersection of Railway Ave/Saskatchewan St to Minto St were finished before the May long weekend. Light traffic only now please.

We are the recipient of an SGI Community Traffic Safety Grant that will see 4 street lights put up along South Elbow Drive to Lakeside Road in July 2024.

We are excited to work with Kandis Miller of Grey Street Studios on marketing materials for the Harbor Golf Community Centre.

Planned repairs are being done at the Water Treatment Plant for mid-June. Notice will be given in advance.

# **BUSINESS LICENCES**

Those businesses that are wishing to temporarily/seasonally set up in the Village (not at the Farmer's Market or on their own commercial property) are asked to purchase a \$100 annual business licence with the Village. You are required to get permission to setup from the property owner as well.

#### WATER REPORTING

The Potable Water System and Distribution System reports from Sask Water are available on our website under Public Notices.

# WATER METER RECONNECTIONS

Returning Seasonal Residents: When you need to have your water meter reconnected, please contact Karen at the Village Office to set up a time. We require 48hrs notice for reconnections and please remember that someone living at the property (or a trusted individual of your choice) must be present at the time of reconnection to ensure that there are no leaks. Water meters will not be reconnected on weekends.

We are embarking on a water meter replacement plan the next few years. If you are on this year's list, we will contact you to have your meter replaced. We plan to replace approximately 30 meters this year so that all of our meters read in cubic meters and replace any that are quite old. At the end of this program, we will have all meters changed/upgraded so that all meter reads will automatically be sent directly to the office. No more in person meter reads!

## GARBAGE & RECYCLING

If you need garbage/recycling roll-out carts contact Karen at the Village Office. Carts may not be able to be dropped off on the day you call in and they will not be dropped off on weekends, so please plan ahead. There is no longer the option for residents to turn these back in for storage while away. If you are away for an extended period of time, please store in a safe place on your property.

#### **REMEMBER:**

• When your garbage and/or recycling carts have been emptied, move them back on to your property and away from the road. The grader or tractor need to maintain the roads and if your cart is on the road, Village Staff do not

have time to move carts back to your property. Maintaining the roads in the village is the priority so there is a very good chance that your cart will be knocked over and could be damaged. Then you would have to replace your cart at your cost.

The **TRANSFER STATION** is now open. Hours have *changed:* Tuesdays 4-7 & Saturdays 10-2

In order to receive notices from the village office, please whitelist (below) in your email accounts <u>through your browser</u> **not** your desktop or phone. Every email carrier is different so we cannot provide instructions for each but it is usually found in settings. In Sasktel.net email addresses, for example: go to your SaskTel email on your web browser, click settings, then spam and add to trusted senders. Will be similar for other email accounts.

Whitelist = Add the following to trusted senders: Telmatik.com (this is where the automated messages for boiled water etc. comes from) <u>elbow@sasktel.net</u> elbow2@sasktel.net

#### TAX NOTICES

Tax Notices were sent the week of May 21-25, 2024. Please contact the office if you did not receive a notice. Taxes are due in full Dec.31, 2024.

#### PAYMENT INFORMATION

Payments for transfer site invoices, construction bin rentals, sea can charges, mowing charges, utility bills and taxes can be made the following ways: Cash, Cheque, Online Banking (PCCU only so far) and by E-Transfer.

# GENERAL ELECTION

Nomination Day for the Village of Elbow General Election is October 9, 2024. This election will be for Mayor and 4 Councillors. The election will be held on Wednesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>. If you wish to register for a mail-in ballot package, you **MUST** register no later than 30 days before the election, which is Friday, October 11, 2024.
