### SAFETY REMINDER

Please remember that the Village of Elbow has an ATV Bylaw #5-2023 available on our website. Please refrain from using the ditch to access other roads. Use Elevator Road to go through the Village.

The speed limit within the Village is 30 km/hour (except for Sask St and Railway Ave South/South Elbow Drive to Putters Lane is 40 km). Some signage has been posted and more is on order.

### COUNCIL NOTES

- Mornings with the Mayor has resumed on Tuesdays – next one is Tuesday, Sept 29th from 10 am to 12 pm. Drop by for coffee and visit with Glen!
- The Paving Information meeting was a great success with over 100 attendees. The questions and answers are being compiled and will be posted on the website shortly. Further public meetings will be advertised.

- We thank everyone for their patience at the HGCC when repairs are required. We know you love this space and we work to ensure it's not just fun but also safe.
- Council is reviewing the Lakeside Road water and sewer planning documents to anticipate future needs for the Childcare centre and Parcel B development.
- We are applying to the SGI Traffic Safety Grant for 3 new streetlights along Railway Avenue North and a digital speed sign for Elevator Road.
- Council is still in talks with CPKC on the Pedestrian Railway Crossing that would be located directly off the west end of Saskatchewan Street (where the existing pathway already crosses the tracks).

### INDUSTRIAL SUBDIVISION LOTS

## HIGHWAY SIGN CORRIDOR

The Village of Elbow has a sign corridor along Highway 19 on both sides of the highway that will start at the ELBOW 1 signs and run for 2 km. Packages are being created and sent out to all businesses in the area. If you are interested and have questions, please give us a call!

## YARD WASTE PICKUP

This will be the week of October 13–16 (right after Thanksgiving). Please put your leaves, etc. in clear, open bags or containers in the alley. Poster will be put up closer to the day with all the details!

## WATER METER DISCONNECTIONS

Seasonal Residents: When you need to have your water meter disconnected, please contact Areta at the Village Office to set up a time.

We require 48hrs notice for disconnections and please remember that someone living at the property (or a trusted individual of your choice) must be present at the time of disconnection to ensure that there are no issues. Water meters will not be disconnected on weekends.

## GARBAGE & RECYCLING

When your garbage and/or recycling carts have been emptied, move them back on to your property and away from the road. The grader or tractor need to maintain the roads and if your cart is on the road, Village Staff do not have time to move carts back to your property. Maintaining the roads in the village is the priority so there is a very good chance that your cart will be knocked over and could be damaged. Then you would have to replace your cart at your cost.

The **TRANSFER STATION** hours are: Tuesdays 3–7 & Saturdays 10–2 until October 31<sup>st</sup> weather dependant.

To receive notices from the village office, please whitelist (below) in your email accounts through your browser not your desktop or phone.

Every email carrier is different so we cannot provide instructions for each but it is usually found in settings. In Sasktel.net email addresses, for example: go to your SaskTel email on your web browser, click settings, then spam and add to trusted senders. Will be similar for other email accounts.
