Village of Elbow Maintenance report November 2023

- Graded roads around the Village and removed some snow.
- I filled in pothole/low spots in allies and around the Village.
- I cleared the sidewalks on Main St. with new snowblower. I think clearing the walks really cleans up the Village and the effort was not that time consuming.
- Brant came out and investigated issues with grader. They filled the tandem oil up, looked
 at snow gate and diagnosed the hydraulic directional control problem. A return trip is in
 the works to repair the hydraulic control.
- Christmas decorations and lights have been put up at village office and on light poles.
- The boiler at the village office required filling and air release from radiators. The system is now balanced and running more efficiently.
- Tested back up distribution pump: it fired up and ran for 10mim.
- Completed maintenance check and repairs on Eazy Kleen power washer. A plugged intake screen was the biggest issue.
- Completed maintenance checks and repairs on Stihl power tools.
- Cleaning and organizing the shop.
- I met Shari the other day. Our meeting went well. We discussed the snow removal route and grader operation. Also, Paul and Troy have been made aware of my time-off and agreed to help if needed.
- The door frame at the main sewer lift station was damaged and a repair is being investigated.
- Cory G. has installed one photo eye on the Main St. lights replacing the programable switch (the other side to follow along with video cameras).
- Village water readings complete.
- Air filters and fan belts ordered for HGCC.
- I will contact Aaron from Flocor and order more radiofrequency devices and begin install in the new year.
- I have not found a source of clay for lagoon yet.
