- An updated version of our Line 19 Community Resource Guide is attached. This guide lists current health-related and non-health-related resources available across the Line 19 region, along with information on how to access them. It will continue to be updated regularly as services in our area grow and change.

Meeting with the Minister of Health – Update

- Members of the Line 19 Health Care Committee met with Minister of Rural and Remote Health Lori Carr and the Ministry representatives to discuss progress and future planning related to primary health care access in the Line 19 region. The discussion was positive, and the Committee was able to share its updated planning work and community survey results. Further conversations with Ministry staff are planned, and updates will be shared as next steps are identified.

Looking Ahead: In 2026, we're aiming to bring visiting primary care services into the Line 19 region through "touchdown sites" (planned clinic days in local communities). While nothing is finalized yet, we're actively planning and advocating to make this happen as an important step toward a permanent clinic.
